CODE OF CONDUCT / 18 and UNDER WAIVER SHEET

This code of conduct identifies the standard of behaviour, which is expected of all Lacrosse Nova Scotia Society (LNSS) members and participants, which for the purpose of this policy shall include all players, guardians, parents, coaches, officials, volunteers, directors, officers, committee members, conveners, team managers, trainers, administrators and employees involved in the LNSS's activities and events.

LNSS is committed to providing an environment in which all individuals are treated with respect. Members and participants of the LNSS shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner consistent with the values of the LNSS, which includes fairness, integrity and mutual respect.

During the course of all LNSS activities and events, members shall avoid behaviour, which brings the LNSS or the sport of lacrosse into disrepute, including but not limited to abusive use of alcohol, use of non-medical drugs and use of alcohol by minors.

LNSS members and participants shall at all times adhere to the LNSS's Memorandum of Association, By-Laws, Operating Policies, Operating Rules and Regulations that govern their events and activities, and to rules and regulations governing any competitions in which the member participates on behalf of the LNSS.

Members and participants of LNSS shall not engage in any activity or behaviour which interferes with a competition or with any player or team's preparation for a competition or which endangers the safety of others.

Members of the LNSS shall refrain from comments or behaviours, which are disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist or sexist. In particular, behaviour, which constitutes harassment or abuse, will not be tolerated, and will be dealt with under the Harassment Operating Policy of the LNSS.

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action in accordance with the Discipline Operating Policy of the LNSS. Such action may result in the member losing the privileges, which come with membership in the LNSS, including the opportunity to participate in LNSS activities and events, both present and future.
